SECOND GRADE

- 4 plastic folders with prongs and pockets (DO NOT WRITE ON THEM)
- Pencil box
- Crayons or coloring pencils
- Glue sticks

- Scissors
- 2 red ballpoint pens
- 2 packs of index cards
- 2 spiral bound notebooks
- Tissue
- Paper towels
- Pencil sharpener
- Headphones for computer lab

Optional Items:

- Baby wipes
- Hand sanitizer
- Ziploc bags
- Color copier paper
- Dry erase markers
- Clorox wipes/Lysol
- Pencil erasers

THIRD GRADE

- 1 pack of Dry Erase Markers

FOURTH GRADE

- One three ring binder 2 inch minimum
- A set of tabbed dividers
- Seven solid color three prong pocket folders
- Crayons and scissors
- 3 ring pencil pouch for binder
- Pencils-plain yellow type
- Notebook paper

FIFTH GRADE

- 5 folders with pockets and prongs
- Wide ruled notebook paper
- Pencils
- Copier paper (optional)
- Tissue
- Headphones for computer lab

INFORMATION ABOUT THE HEAD- PHONES NEEDED FOR THE COMPUTER LAB

All students are required to have headphones for the computer lab. An inexpensive set of computer headphones will work as long as it has a stereo mini connector (not the 1/4 connector). Mono headphones, although usable, will only provide sound in one ear. Ear bud headphones are also acceptable.

Please send a plastic Ziploc-type storage bag for storing the headphones. Please insert a piece of paper inside the bag with the child’s name on it.

Headphones may be used from year-to-year.

The computer lab does not provide headphones.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION
